IV. Treasurer's report

Treasurer's report: \$16,256.91. BLYFA \$ 9,165.38, Booster \$5,222.44, Individual Fundraiser \$ 1,869.09. There is a pending deposit of \$95.00 from Pizza Ranch night. Kim notified the board that the monthly storage fee is increasing by \$7 per month, From \$111.00 to \$118.00. Kim will research new storage facilities and prices.

V. Uniforms

Amy will be looking into popular options for youth

and adult apparel to be sold online. Neil motioned for Intro to get reversible jerseys this year, Kim seconded. Players entering 3rd grade will get a \$15 coupon code at registration to offset new jersey cost.

VI. Registration

Wednesday June 10th 5:30-8:00pm will be the final date to register a player without the late fee penalty. The location will be determined of final registration at April board meeting. May 1st flyers will be distributed to schools for students to bring home to parents with dates, times and location of football registration. Amy and Heather will have flyers for school and community ed book handed into Paula on Tuesday March 10th. Online registration will go live on April 16th.

VII. Heads Up Coach's Training

Brady researched Heads Up, it will cost the association \$340 to train all head coaches and their assistant coaches. Kim motioned to send all directors to heads up training so they can become certified, level one player safety coordinators, Brady seconded. Board approved training for coaches and directors. If coaches do not complete training, they will not be allowed to coach.

The board approved changes to intro football schedule. Intro will now have three scrimmages, three games and also two tournaments to participate in. Games will now be on Thursdays with official Refs. Neil, Craig and Brady will have a meeting with intro coaches to discuss the new schedule as well as expectations from the board in regards to the intro program.
